

BBYO - Terms and Conditions – Camp BBYO 2025

1. Payment

Payment is due within 48 hours of sign up in order to confirm your place. The deposit amount is £350.00. If you require more time to pay the deposit please notify us by emailing office@bbyo.org.uk

Please note that the remaining balance for Camp BBYO will be requested in writing on 1st April 2025, and total amount due will depend on whether you registered before the early bird expires. Please check the brochure on our website for the up-to-date price of camp.

2. Cancellations & Refunds

In the event that an applicant for Camp BBYO decides to withdraw or cancel their participation / application they should notify BBYO as soon as possible by email to office@bbyo.org.uk

A £350.00 deposit is required to process your place, which is non-refundable unless alternative arrangements have been agreed with BBYO.

BBYO reserves the right to cancel, amend or curtail any activity associated with Camp BBYO as a result of any situation beyond its reasonable control, such as extreme weather, industrial action, withdrawal of services by a supplier or infectious disease (inc Covid). In such circumstances, BBYO reserves the right not to make any refund of monies paid. You are therefore advised to obtain appropriate insurance to cover such eventualities.

3. Travel Arrangements & Authorised Absence

Travel to and from is provided by BBYO at no extra cost. Travel from Greater London will be via coach, however the travel methods from other cities will depend on demand.

4. Leaving our camps / Visitors our camps & events

Participants are not allowed to leave our residential sites or separate from the main group without express permission. If permission is granted participants will only be able to leave with a leader present.

Visitors (whether friends or family or otherwise) are not allowed to visit our camp or any event without express permission.

5. Compliance with Code of Conduct

Participants are required to comply with the BBYO Code of Conduct. Breach of the Code of Conduct by any Participant will be treated as a serious breach of the Code of Conduct. If a participant(s) breaches the code of conduct BBYO reserves the right to issue warnings (strikes) and / or remove participants from the programme.

BBYO may update or revise the Code of Conduct at any time.

We recommend that participants and parents / guardians read BBYO's Code of Conduct.

6. Searching

If there is a reasonable suspicion that any Participant is in possession of unauthorised medication, drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons or has access to physical or online / electronic material that is inappropriate, BBYO reserves the right to search a Participant's personal possessions or bed / sleeping area during the programme. If prevented from carrying out any such search, BBYO is entitled to take this as an indication that such prohibited items may be in the possession or under the control of such Participant.

7. Medical

Participants and their parents / guardians are required to complete the BBYO Medical Form promptly when requested and to disclose all relevant conditions and information and to update any such information prior to the programme.

8. Early Termination of Participation at Camps & Events

If:

- (a) a Participant elects to withdraw from the programme before the end of the programme (whether that fact is expressly communicated to BBYO or becomes evident to the leaders); or
- (b) a Participant is removed from the programme as a result of a failure to comply with the Code of Conduct or other behavioural reasons.

BBYO shall not be responsible for any costs incurred by the Participant in returning home (or any other costs after the date of leaving or being removed from the programme). To the extent reasonable, BBYO shall communicate with the parents / guardians of any Participant who voluntarily withdraws from or is removed from the programme with a view to making travel arrangements for any such Participant (at the cost of the Participant and their parents / guardians).

Any Participant who has been awarded a bursary contribution towards the cost of the programme by BBYO and voluntarily withdraws from or is removed before the end may be required to repay some or all of the amount of the bursary awarded to them. Such requirement will be notified to the Participant or their parents / guardians and such repayment should be made within 28 days of the date of such notification.

9. Kashrut Policy

Food provided at Camp BBYO will be kosher-style meals, such as vegetarian buffet meals, which are cooked and prepared on BBYO owned kitchen equipment. If a participant requires glatt kosher meals at camp their parent / guardian should email office@bbyo.org.uk
